

RULES



FIREARMS SAFETY

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot.
3. Do not point at or cover anything with the muzzle you do not intend to shoot.
4. Be certain of your line of fire and backstop. If you aren't sure, don't shoot.

EAR PROTECTION TIP

Buy foam earplugs in bulk and stash them in your range bag, purse and glove compartment. This way you always have ear protection when you're ready to shoot.

CHECK YOUR EYE PRO

Make sure your eye protection is serviceable and is American National Standards Institute (ANSI) rated for safety.

LEAD AWARENESS

Wash your hands and face (cold water) before eating or drinking on the range and when you are finished shooting to reduce the risk of lead poisoning.
